TEACHING AT BIBLICAL SCHOOL OF THEOLOGY, YANGON, MYANMAR

God blessed our team (Bill and Rita Johnson and John Sanders) with safe travel to Yangon, Myanmar (Burma). In no time at all we have fallen in love with these people and have become heart-broken at the control Buddhism and Animism have on the masses. Praise the Lord there is, however, a strong presence of Bible believing Baptists who are making a difference in many parts of the country.

Each of us is lecturing thirteen hours to the students of the Biblical School of Theology where ICP translator Paul's brother, Timothy, serves as president. There are about 130 students in this school which occupies a nice three-story building sitting on property provided a few years ago by Trinity Missionary Baptist Church of West Memphis, Arkansas.

John has had the privilege of teaching evangelism to a class of fourth year students. Friday and Saturday will be spent fellowshipping with and ministering to a group of Myanmar missionaries six hours southwest of Yangon.

Rita is helping a group of third year students learn some of the idiomatic expressions and other common grammatical problems for Burmese people who want to learn English.

Brother Bill is teaching the fundamentals of Christian education in and for churches. This has given an opportunity to test the effectiveness of the new values formation materials being developed for special use in the Philippines and other countries in need of a transformation to the moral principles of Christianity. These students have come from several areas of

Myanmar, a country with about the same land area as Texas. They represent more than half a dozen language groups in the nation, however they have the Burmese language and English as common second and third languages.

The team will spend Friday and Saturday fellowshipping with and ministering to a group of Myanmar church planters six hours southwest of Yangon.

Because of the love of so many individuals and churches, we are looking forward to distributing over 5,000 Tagalog language Bibles and thousands of John/Romans in two languages in the Philippines.

We will return to the Philippines on Sunday afternoon, Feb. 14. The second container from World Wide Literature is due to arrive there any day. It contains student chairs, Sunday school books, additional school books and so many more things to enhance the ministry of ICP/His Offspring Ministries in the Philippines.

ICP/ACP Romania is distributing more books every month. The new VBS series is almost ready for publication. Please continue to pray for Liviu Clinciu's wife in Romania. Ramona continues to have problems with Lupus.
